VIP Card - Curt Olsen presented the VIP Card as a fundraiser for Project Graduation. They are similar to the coupon books that are sold by other organizations. Sell the cards for \$20.00 each Proj. Grad. will make \$10.00 from each one sold. Would like for all senior students to sell 10 cards each. He suggested having a committee that would be responsible for smaller groups of students making it easier to track the sell of the cards. Once sold the cards are good for one year. All lost or stolen cards will be the responsibility of Proj. Grad.
